

The company Phones-for-all wish to erect a 36m high phone mast near the A3, to the north-east of Guildford and south east-of Woking.

Within the surrounding areas there are sites of importance consisting of;

**Sites of Special Scientific Interest and Local Nature Reserves**

- SSSI - 'Papercourt' situated within 1.5km to the north-west of the proposed site
- SSSI and LNR - 'White Rose Lane' within 4km to the north-west of the proposed site
- SSSI and LNR - 'Ockham and Wisley' approximately 4km to the north-east of the proposed site

**Ancient Woodland**

- 500m and 3km to the south-west of the proposed site
- 1.5km to the north-east and south of the proposed site
- 3.5km to the east of the proposed site

**Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and Area of Great Landscape Value**

- Approximately 4.5km to the south-east of the proposed site

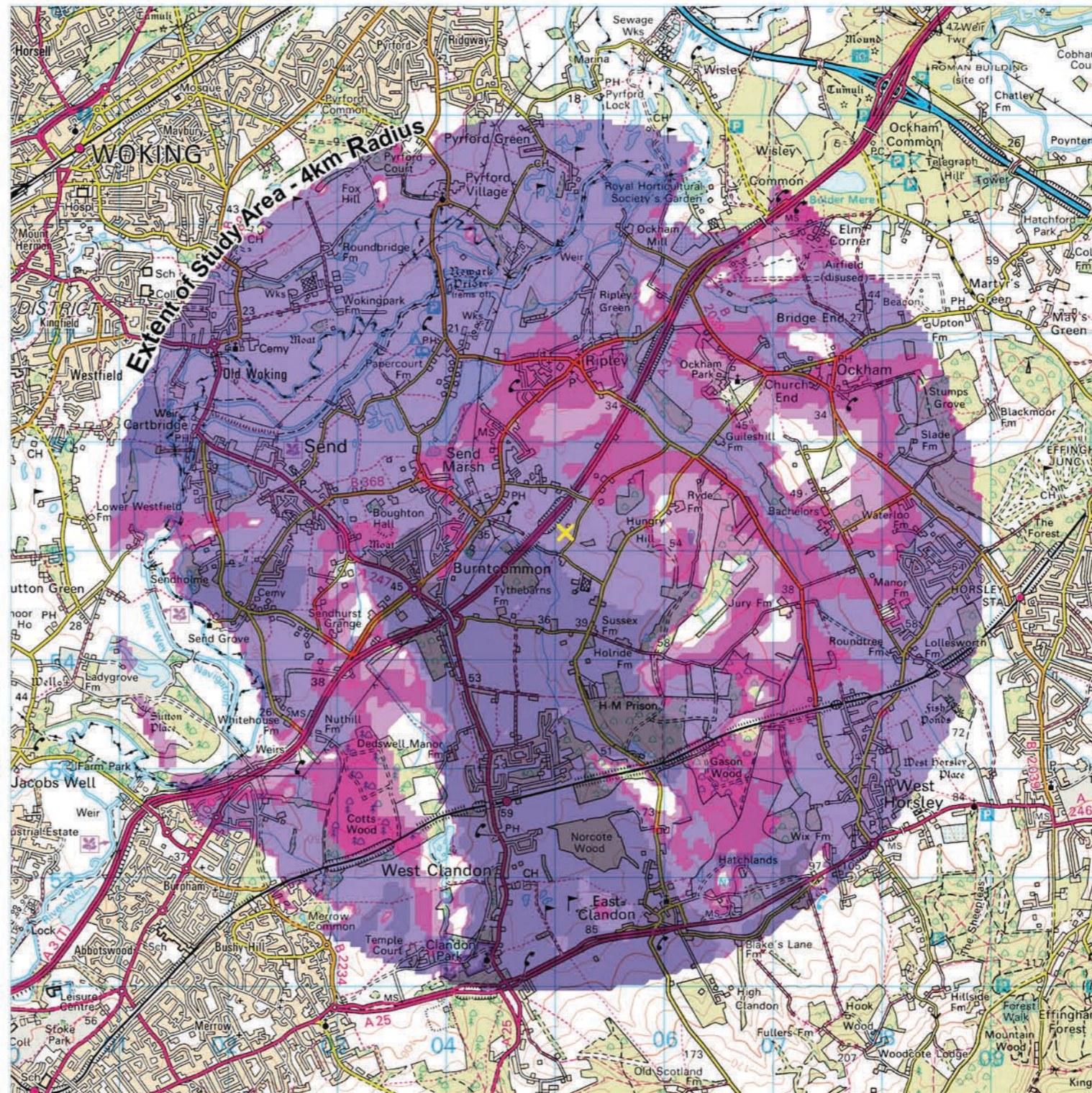
**National Trust Sites**

- Clandon Park situated 4km to the south and Hatchlands Park 4km to the south-east of the proposed site

**Royal Horticulture Sites**

- Wisley Gardens within 4km to the north-east of the proposed site

**Numerous footpaths, bridleways and cycle routes surround the proposed site.**

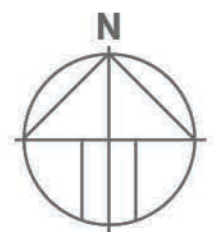


- The results indicate the proposed mast will potentially be visible from the majority of the 4km study area. The phone mast potentially cannot be seen from 9.63% of the study area.

- The visibility mapping is created using Digital Terrain Modelling (DTM) using digital elevation data and does not take into account structures such as buildings or trees/woodland which may affect the visibility of the proposed mast further.

- 4 Points Visible** - 36m of the mast is visible
- 3 Points Visible** - 24m of the mast is visible
- 2 Points Visible** - 12m of the mast is visible
- 1 Points Visible** - Below 12m of the mast is visible
